Note: The Multiple Choice Exam (MCE) can only be taken by those that qualify for the Kennel Club JEP Level 1.

*The A3 Hands-On Assessment is for those eligible and following the traditional judge's system to progress to the A3/A2 List. *Please note that numbers are limited for this assessment.* Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
