Definition of classes

- In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.
- Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.
- If a dog is owned in partnership and entered in Members' Classes or competing for Members' Specials, each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.
- In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of postal entries shall be counted when entering for any class, i.e. **Tuesday 20th August**
- Wins in Variety Classes do not count for entry in Breed Classes, but when entering for Variety Classes, wins in both Breed and Variety Classes must be counted. A First Prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.
- If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:

1. WITHDRAWAL.

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulation 20.

2. TRANSFER.

a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height, and in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.

b) If an exhibit is entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy, Puppy or Junior class which is over age but under 12, 18 or 24 months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Puppy, Junior or Yearling class respectively for the correct colour, sex, weight or height, and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.

c) For any reason other than the above, The Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct colour, sex, weight or height.

d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY: For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

PUPPY : For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR : For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING: For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

NOVICE : For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

GRADUATE : For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or four or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Graduate, Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

POST GRADUATE : For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate/CACIB/CAC/Green Star or five or more First Prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open classes, whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

LIMIT : For dogs which have not become Show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any Governing Body recognised by the Kennel Club, or won 3 or more CC/CACIB/CAC/Green Stars or won seven or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows, in Limit or Open classes confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN : For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

SCOTTISH BRED: For all dogs or bitches whelped in Scotland.

VETERAN : For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day of the Show.

SPECIAL WORKING: For dogs holding the Club's Intermediate or Senior Working Test Diploma, placed 1st 2nd or 3rd in Obedience Classes, Novice or above, at Limited, Open or Championship Obedience Shows, or qualified at Open or Championship working trials.

SPECIAL BEGINNERS: For owner, handler or dog not having won a First Prize at a Championship or Open Show.

SPECIAL CHAMPION: For dogs and bitches confirmed as Champions by their appropriate Kennel Club.

BRACE: For two dogs (either sex or mixed) of one breed, belonging to the same exhibitor, each dog having been entered in some class other than Brace or Team.

SPECIAL OPEN (CI 27): As per Open – proceeds from this class go to Bearded Collie Rescue.

NOT FOR COMPETITION: See Regulations 8 & 18.

Rules and Regulations

1. The Show will open at 9.15 a.m.
2. Dogs will be received until 12 noon after which no dogs will be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show management.
3. Judging will commence at 10 a.m.
4. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. **ENTRY FEES:** Members £4.00 first class; £1.00 each subsequent class (same dog) and Brace; Non-members £5.00 first class; £1.50 each subsequent class (same dog) and Brace; NFC £1.00; **Membership Fees:** Single £9.00; Joint £10.00
6. No prize money is on offer at this Show.
7. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
8. Puppies under 6 months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible for competition. Entries 'Not For Competition' will be accepted for puppies over 4 months of age on the day of the Show. Please complete all details on the entry form.
9. The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
10. **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW:** The Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same Show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed or Best in Show is a puppy, it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Where the Reserve Best in Show is a Puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog, it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show.
11. **BEST IN SHOW:** Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show.
12. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of 10 minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show management.
13. Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them, nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not to touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
14. All competitors must be familiar with the Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) – Regulations for the preparation of dogs for exhibition.
15. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without such a number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
16. **DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS**
Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help you through the 'dos' and 'don'ts' when travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
 - Please take a moment to consider whether the route to a show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade, e.g. a large umbrella, and always have plenty of water to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember, if you feel hot, your dog is likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, which could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING – IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK, FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY, WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

Right to refuse Entries – exhibitors/competitors are reminded that Show Societies have the right under KC Regulation to refuse any entry.

17. Anyone whose dog is entered at a KC licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dogs are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of KC Regulations in this respect may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars or prong collars is not permitted at any show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.
18. 'Not For Competition' entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form, and the dog must be KC registered.
19. No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
20. Should a Scheduled judge be unable to fulfil the appointment, the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition, but entry fees will not be refunded.
21. Any Rule or Regulation or statement of the nature of a rule or regulation, which appears for convenience in another part of this schedule, shall have the same force as these regulations.
22. All entries must be made on or before the closing date for entries (postmark) upon the entry forms provided for that purpose. All entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate entry fees or the entry will not be accepted. If a written acknowledgement of receipt of entries is required then a SAE must be enclosed.
23. No animal other than an exhibit shall be brought into the precincts of the Show during its continuance, except dogs registered to assist the disabled or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the Committee. However, at the discretion of the Show Society a dog brought by a spectator may be admitted with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration that the dog is free from disease and that it will be kept under proper control at all times.
24. Exhibitors showing dogs are not permitted to hold any conversation with the judge during the competition, and any exhibitor who persists in addressing the judge after being requested not to do so by the ring steward, the judge or any member of the Committee may be disqualified and reported to the Kennel Club. No person other than the exhibitor and officials may be in the ring during judging.
25. If in the opinion of the Show Secretary, Show Manager or Judge any dog is considered not to be in a fit state for exhibition owing to disease, savage disposition, or any other cause, the dog may be excluded or removed from the Show on the instructions of the Show management. Thereafter the dog must not return to the Show at any time under any circumstances, and the case must be reported to the Kennel Club within seven days.
26. The Committee, whilst most anxious for the care and safety of dogs, exhibitors and exhibitors' property, will not be responsible for any loss, detention or damage to the same, whether arising from accident or any other cause whatever, nor for any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants or others; it is on this understanding only that entries are accepted.
27. The officers and Committee of the Show accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by the stand-holders at the Show, and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of Regulation F(B) – Preparation of dogs for exhibition.
28. **Dog Fouling:** Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dogs at any KC licensed show, both within the licensed area and within environs such as car and caravan parks and approaches. Receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION - F(B)

These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and / or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A 42.

1. (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the Show and from any award gained thereat.
(b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations the he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A 42.
2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the Show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present at any time during the Show.
(b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed, except:
 - (a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee
 - (b) The removal of dew claws of any breed.
 - (c) Operations to prevent breeding, providing that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.Nor must anything be done calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may however be lodged by an official of the Show, or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate) to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show, and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the fact that any coat preparation or shampoo or similar mentioned in either Schedule or Catalogue does not imply that the use of such preparations may not contravene Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F (annex B). This also applies to any coat preparation or shampoo or similar on sale at the show. The attention of exhibitors is directed to the Declaration they are required to sign on the entry form.

DECLARATION: I/We agree to submit to and be bound by KC Ltd Rules and Regulations in their present form or as they may be amended from time to time in relation to all canine matters with which the KC is concerned, and that this entry is made upon the basis that all current single or joint registered owners of each dog have authorised/consented to this entry.

I/We also undertake to abide by the regulations of this show and not to bring to the show any dog which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the show, or which is suffering from a visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare, nor to bring any dog which has been prepared for exhibition contrary to KC regulations for the preparation of dogs for exhibition F (Annex B).

I/We agree without reservation that any Veterinary Surgeon operating on any of my/our dogs in such a way as to alter the natural conformation of the dog or part thereof may report such operations to the KC, and further declare that where any alteration has been made to a dog's natural conformation the relevant permission to show has been granted by the KC.

I/We further declare that to the best of my/our knowledge, no dog is liable to disqualification under KC show regulations.
