The seminar will include a presentation on the history of Bearded Collie, an understanding of the construction, movement, function and purpose of the Beardie and an in-depth presentation of the Kennel Club Bearded Collie Breed Standard.

For judges progressing through the Kennel Club JEP (Judges Education Programme) route, attendance at the BAD and passing the MCE is a mandatory requirement to enable you to progress from Level 1 to Level 2.

The BAD is open to everyone. Candidates wishing to undertake the multiple-choice exam (MCE) must at least be a JEP Level 1 judge, appearing on KC 'Find a Judge'.

Group Mentoring is open only to judges who meet JEP Level 2 criteria, and candidates attending the BAD that pass the MCE on the day. Number of places are limited and will be allocated in order of bookings received.
